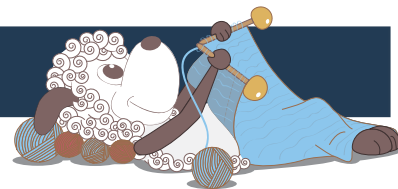


Idonia - a gorgeous shawl

A delicate and very soft lace shawl worked in a classic lace pattern named "gothic windows". The shawl is large enough to be worn as a shawl, but light enough to be worn wrapped around the neck as a large scarf.

Materials

350 g of Indiecita by Filcolana in color 100 (Natural White)
3,5 mm needles

Size

One size

Measurements

approx. 65 x 180 cm

Gauge

22 sts and 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm
- achieving the exact gauge is not essential, but any deviation will affect the finished size of the shawl as well the amount of yarn used

Pattern

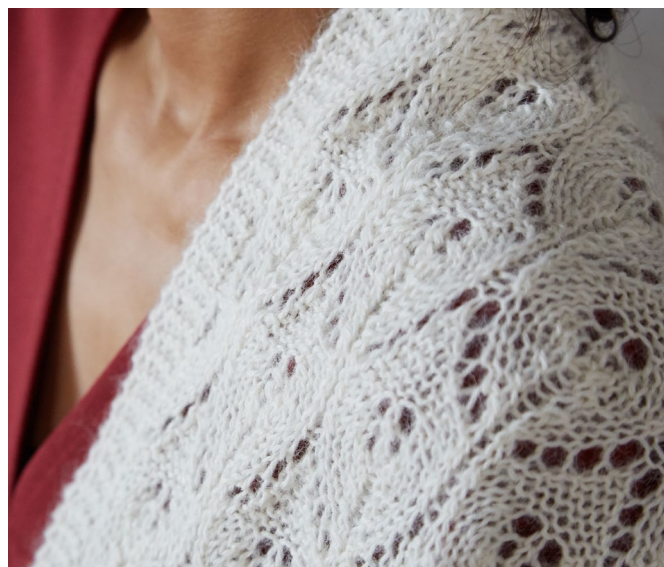
Work according to chart (Row 1 is read from right to left)
The number of stitches is divisible by 12 + 1.

Shawl

Cast on 143 sts on 3,5 mm needle.
Knit 7 rows.

Next row (RS): K5, work the charted pattern repeat 11 times, k5.

Continue as established, working the first and last sts



in garter stitch (knit on every row).
 Work the chart a total of 17 times (or more, for a longer shawl).
 Knit 7 rows. Bind off.

Gently rinse and block the shawl.

Chart

← Begin here

- Knit on the RS, purl on the WS
- Purl on the RS, knit on the WS
- Yarn over
- K2tog
- Skp
