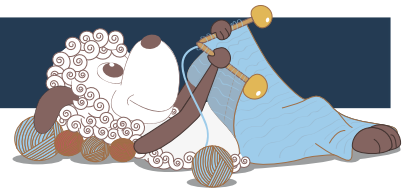


# Fagus - a crocheted hat in rib

An easy hat in crochet rib pattern is always useful. It is easy and fast to crochet and wonderful to wear in this light and warm yarn combination. The pattern uses UK terms.

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English translation: Sidsel Sangild

## Materials

20 (25) 25 (30) g New Zealand lammeuld from Filcolana cl. 210  
15 (20) 20 (20) g Tilia from Filcolana cl. 326 (Meadow)  
Crochet with one thread of each yarn held together throughout.  
Crochet hook: 5 mm

## Sizes

Child, teen, small adult, large adult  
Fits head circumference: 52-54 (55-57) 58-60 (61-64) cm

## Gauge

11 rows, 15 st = 10 cm measured in double crochet in the back loop only

## Note

The hat is crocheted as a square. Sew or crochet the side seam and pull the top together.

## Pattern

Ch 33 (37) 41 (41)

**Row 1:** 1 dc in 2nd ch from the hook, 1 dc in each of the next 6 (8) 9 (9) ch, 1 htr in each of the next 22 (24) 25 (25) ch, 1 dc in each of the last 5 ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, 1 dc in the back loop only in each of the first 5 dc, 1 htr in the back loop only in each of the next 22 (24) 25 (25) htr, 1 dc in the back loop only in each of the last 7 (9) 10 (10) dc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, dc in the back loop only in each of the first 7 (9) 10 (10) dc, 1 htr in the back loop only in each of the next 22 (24) 25 (25) htr, 1 dc in the back loop only in each of the last 5 dc, turn.

Repeat row 2-3, until a total of 51 (55) 57 (61) rows, or until the piece measures approximately 46 (51) 53 (56) cm.

Sew or crochet the side seam together with sl st.

Break yarn with a long yarn end, weave the yarn end through the row ends in the end with 5 dc and pull the top of the hat together. Fasten with a few stitches on the wrong side.  
Weave in ends.
